ITEM #1: Meeting Called to Order:

Kevin Diamond called the meeting to order at 5:30pm.

ITEM #2: Public Comments: No public comments.

ITEM #3: Approval of the Agenda:

MOTION by Lori Judd: That the Legislative Regulations Committee approves the agenda in its entirety. Motion seconded by Pauline May, all in favor, motion moves forward.

ITEM #4: **Regulation Relating to Fees Outlined in SB 191:** William LaBorde presented language for a proposed regulation that outlines the fee structure pursuant to SB 191. A copy is attached and will be kept on file. No further comments.

Motion by Lori Judd: That the Legislative Regulations Committee approves the proposed regulation and will present the language to the Board for their review and approval. Motion seconded by Kevin Diamond, all in favor, motion moves forward.

ITEM #5: **Review LCB File No. R112-23:** William LaBorde presented R112-23, now identified as R044-25. Upon review by the committee, it was determined to place this file on hold until the next scheduled committee meeting for further discussion. No further comments.

Motion by Kevin Diamond: That the Legislative Regulations Committee will move this matter relating to R044-25 to the next scheduled committee meeting. Motion seconded by Lori Judd, all in favor, motion moves forward.

ITEM #6: **Review LCB File No. R193-22:** William LaBorde presented R193-22 to the committee. Upon review and discussion, it was determined that further review is needed since time has passed from the initial introduction of this proposed regulation. William LaBorde and Kevin Diamond were assigned to review the file and they will present their findings at the next committee meeting. No further comments.

Motion by Kevin Diamond: That the Legislative Regulations Committee will assign William LaBorde and Kevin Diamond to conduct a review of R193-22 and they will present their findings at the next scheduled committee meeting. Motion seconded by Pauline May, all in favor, motion moves forward.

ITEM #7: **Formulate a Regulation to Provide a Certificate of Endorsement:** William LaBorde presented language for a proposed regulation to allow the Board to provide a certificate of endorsement, pursuant to NRS 622.530. Upon discussion, it was determined to add language that provides reciprocity for a qualified active member of Armed Forces, member's spouse, veteran or veteran's surviving spouse, pursuant to NRS 622.510. No further comments. A copy is attached and will be kept on file.

Motion by Kevin Diamond: That the Legislative Regulations Committee approves of the proposed regulation and will present the language to the Board for their review and approval. Motion seconded by Lori Judd, all in favor, motion moves forward.

Motion amended by Kevin Diamond: That the Legislative Regulations Committee approves of the proposed regulation and will add language that will provide reciprocity for a qualified active member of Armed Forces, member's spouse, veteran or veteran's surviving spouse. Motion seconded by Lori Judd, all in favor, motion moves forward.

ITEM #8: Formulate a Regulation for Court Reporters to Provide Certain Information: William LaBorde presented proposed language that requires the certified court reporter to state on the record and provide certain information; this information will ensure that all parties have knowledge they have a certified court reporter and a licensed court reporting firm reporting and producing a transcript of the proceeding. No further comments. A copy is attached and will be kept on file.

Motion by Kevin Diamond: That the Legislative Regulations Committee approve the proposed language and will present the language to Board for their review and approval. Motion seconded by Lori Judd, all in favor, motion moves forward.

Motion amended by Kevin Diamond: That the Legislative Regulations Committee approve the proposed language and will add the words “if any” after the words “business address” in NAC 656.350(2)(b). Motion seconded by Lori, all in favor, motion moves forward.

ITEM #9: Review Proposed Language for Unlicensed Practices: William LaBorde made a preference to language taken from SB 191 relating to unlicensed practices. Kevin Diamond suggested that language relating to unlicensed practices should be a stand-alone regulation and not combined with other proposed regulations. Further research and discussion is needed. No further comments.

Motion by Lori Judd: That the Legislative Regulations Committee will conduct further research in formulating language for unlicensed practices. Motion seconded by Pauline May, all in favor, motion moves forward.

ITEM #10: Next Meeting Date and Agenda Items: The meeting date and agenda items will be determined at a later date. No further comments.

At the discretion of the Chair, public comments were accepted.

Public Comments: Cindy Pfingston posed a question relating to digital reporting. The Chair reminded Ms. Pfingston that the public comment section is not open for questions and dialogue, it is for comments only. No further comments.
